ENGLAND



ROLLS-ROYCE MOTORCARS in Chichester

The ultimate in luxury and elegance. Applicants must be US citizens, preferably with junior, senior or graduate academic standing in the field of mechanical, automotive, electrical engineering with high interest in quality and process management control. Duration: six months. Monthly stipend of £1000 (US\$ 1900). Customized production of only four cars per day.



MINI COOPER in Oxford

Applicants must be US citizens preferably with junior, senior, or graduate academic standing in the field of mechanical, automotive, electrical or acoustic engineering. Duration: 4 - 6 months. Stipend pays £1100 per month (US\$ 2000). Annual production of 220,000 cars.

GERMANY



PORSCHE (some German required)

Stuttgart R&D facility (Weissach) or Leipzig. Advanced academic standing in mechanical or electrical engineering. Monthly stipend € 600 (US \$ 780). Duration: summer, three months or longer.



BMW (some German required)

- a. Assembly work at the Regensburg plant producing the 1-model. Or choose the Landshut plant (rear axle, differential, dashboards, fenders, rebuilding of old engines, iron foundry). Perfect for sophomores or juniors. Internship lasts three months in summer only. Monthly net salary € 1,600 (US \$ 2,000).
- b. Munich plant: engine assembly. Monthly stipend €800 (US \$ 1000) per month or assembly work (US \$ 2000) for mechanical engineering majors
- c. Leipzig plant: production of 3-series cars. US \$ 800 per month) for mechanical engineering majors.



MAN truck assembly plant in Munich. Some German required. € 500 (US\$ 600) per month. Three months duration.



BROSE, located in Coburg (some German required) For majors in mechanical and/or electrical engineering, or material science. Major European producer of electric windows and seat mechanisms. Duration: 4 - 6 months. Monthly stipend of € 600 (US \$ 780) and the company reimburses the student for airfare.
