

This thirteen-story commercial complex with 241 stores is one of Ginza's largest facilities and Tokyo's high-end fashion center. The building also has an expansive rooftop garden area for great views of Tokyo, and on the basement floor, a traditional Noh

A temple of the Hongwanii school of the Jodoshinshu sect of the Buddhism. Its building, which is built in an ancient Indian architecture style, is eye-catching. The main hall, pillars of the San-mon gate, and stone walls were designated as Important Cultural Properties in 2014.

A complex facility consisting of the Kabukiza and KABUKIZA Tower. After the 4th Kabukiza was closed for a period of three years, the reconstruction was finally completed in 2013.

Higashi-ginza (Subway: A11, H09)

2-a Kabukiza Theatre

The only Kabuki theater in the world was built in 1889, recently celebrating its 130th anniversary. It has maintained its refined classical theater since the Meiji era, and has continued to present performances that incorporate the spirit of the times. The 5th incarnation of the theater, designed by architect Kuma Kengo, is a masterpiece of tradition and innovation.

KABUKIZA Tower

An office tower that emphasizes traditional Japanese aesthetics, built adjacently to the Kabukiza. The Kabukiza Gallery, which lets visitors experience the world of Kabuki even on days without performances, is also popular. (910:00-17:30 (admission until 17:00)
